#### STATEMENT OF FAITH

- 1. We believe in the verbal, plenary inspiration of both the Old and New Testaments, i.e. that the very words of the original Scriptures are inerrant and that they are our final and absolute authority in every area of life and knowledge (II Tim. 3:15, I Peter 1:23-25, Heb 4:12).

- 3. We believe that Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and that He is both undiminished deity and genuine humanity in one person forever (Isa. 7:14, Matt. 1:23, Luke 1:27).
- 4. We believe that God the Holy Spirit is a personal being who convicts the world of sin and who regenerates, indwells, empowers, guides, and bestows spiritual gifts on believers (Luke 24:40, Acts 1:4-8, Acts 15:7-9, I Cor. 12:1-31).
- 5. We believe that man was created by a direct act of God in His image, not from previously existing life, that all men sinned in Adam (the historical father of the entire human race) and thus incurred both physical and spiritual death; and that all men/women have inherited a sinful nature (Gen. 1:26-31, Rom. 5:12-21).
- 6. We believe that Jesus Christ died as a substitutionary sacrifice for our sins and that, through faith in Him as Lord and Savior, we are declared righteous by God and are eternally secure in Christ as long as we remain faithful to Him (Psa. 103:3, Rom. 3:24, Eph. 2:8).
