Camp Dates	Session 1: June 1 – June 26, 2026 Session 2: July 6 – July 31, 2026
Camp Hours	7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. , Monday through Friday Building opens at 7:00 a.m. – not before.
Ages	6 to 13 years old Camper must have completed kindergarten.
Office Hours	Monday – Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. All payments must be made at the school office. Counselors cannot accept payments.

\$50 per camper · per session

SESSION FEE

\$525 per camper · per session

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Families enrolling 3 or more campers receive a **10% discount** on each session.

i. Payment Policy.

At Enrollment

A **registration fee of \$50** and the **first deposit of \$175** are due at the time of enrollment per camper.

All payments must be made at the school office. Counselors cannot accept payments.

Second Deposit

\$175 per camper, due by Friday of the **first week** of each session.

Third Deposit

\$175 per camper, due by Friday of the **second week** of each session.

Late Payments

If a deposit is not paid by Friday, a **\$5 late fee** applies. If no payment is received by Monday, your child may not come to day camp until the balance is paid. Your account must stay current.

There are no refunds on camp fees.

ii. Four-Week Program Rules.

<i>Sessions</i>	Daycamp runs two (2) four-week sessions. You may register for one session, the other, or both . You are responsible for the full cost of every session enrolled.
<i>Late Pick-Up</i>	Daycamp closes promptly at 6:00 p.m. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be assessed for any late pick-up.

iii. Daily Camp Life.

<i>Swim & Pool Pass</i>	All campers need an Annual Pass from The Station at Central Park Aquatic Center in Moore. Passes must be purchased by May 31 , even if attending only the second session. Visit the Station's website for pricing.
<i>Dress Code</i>	Pack socks daily — skating or bowling may replace the planned activity in case of inclement weather. Shoes must be worn at all times. Modest swimwear required at the pool. Public pools do not permit denim shorts (hemmed or not). Campers without swimwear cannot enter the pools.
<i>Sunscreen</i>	Each child is required to bring their own sunscreen , clearly labeled with their name. Reapplication is the camper's responsibility, with staff supervision before leaving for outdoor activities.
<i>Electronics</i>	Permitted on Fridays only . Parents are responsible for ensuring appropriate parental controls are in place.
<i>Personal Items</i>	Label everything with your child's name. Items must travel in a backpack or zippered enclosure. Daycamp personnel are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
<i>Meals</i>	Campers bring their own two snacks and a lunch each day, in an insulated cooler with a water bottle . A snack bar is available for afternoon purchases. If a camper forgets lunch, parents will be called to deliver one — the camp does not provide lunches or snacks.
<i>Drop Off & Pick Up</i>	Drop off and pick up happen in the cafeteria , Monday through Friday.

*An adult must **check in** each child every morning
and must **sign out** each child every evening.*
